This transition meeting led to a Strategic Planning meeting held on July 25, 2008.

Michael Morley, Newsletter, headed up recruiting a student intern to update the membership brochure, which is in the process of being finalized. Robert Windle, membership, continues to send reminders to members as memberships expire and headed up starting a LinkedIn account for OCDA to share information with our membership. We have also

highlighted a member in issues of OCDA's newsletter.

It was determined by the Executive Board that we would partner with the Ohio Counseling Association and present a career focused session at the All Ohio Counseling Conference in November in recognition of National Career Development Month. This spring, the OCDA Board of Directors designated Mimi Patterson and Kevin Glavin as Life Members of OCDA. Announced at the Spring Conference at the University of Akron, Mimi and Kevin are being recognized for their many contributions to the career development field and more specifically in appreciation of their service and leadership to OCDA.

Mimi Patterson served OCDA as President and served in other capacities as well; most recently she served



as Membership Chair. Now retired, she was employed for 10 years at InfoPlace (now known as the Career Center) at the Cuyahoga County Public Library. She retains her Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC); while employed, she was a National Certified Counselor (NCC).
